

RE: NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF AMENDMENTS TO DISTRIBUTION  
POLICIES OF THE  
BRAIN AND SPINAL INJURY TRUST FUND COMMISSION, EFFECTIVE  
July 1, 2023

To Whom It May Concern:

Notice is hereby given to all interested parties that the Brain and Spinal Injury Trust Fund Commission, a Commission of the State of Georgia, has amended its DISTRIBUTION POLICIES, to become effective July 1, 2023, and voted to approve the final revision at its meeting on March 23, 2023. Comments from the public will be considered and accepted for 30 days beginning June 1, 2023. These policies were initially adopted July 9, 2002, and last amended on February 1, 2017. The most recent revisions made to the policies are outlined below. These policies relate to distributions from the Brain and Spinal Injury Trust Fund, as authorized by Official Code of Georgia Annotated, Section 15-21-140, et seq. (as amended in 2002, Act No. 748 (S.B. 364)).

#### Summary of Amendments

- The lifetime cap for BSITFC grants to individuals is increased to \$12,000 from \$10,000 – the increase is not retroactive to grant applications received or funded prior to July 1, 2023
- The cap for modified vehicle grants is increased to \$18,000 from \$15,000 – the increase is not retroactive to grant applications received or funded prior to July 1, 2023
- The cap for vehicle modification grants is increased to \$18,000 from \$15,000 – the increase is not retroactive to grant applications received or funded prior to July 1, 2023.
